Job Description and Duties:

- Minimum of teaching 2 days a week (more is preferred) often between the hours of 9am and 1pm with limited afternoon classes & weekends. - Preferred: Ability to play the guitar, ukulele or piano.
- Flexibility with in-person and online teaching and ability to teach from our studio on Burnet Rd in Austin, TX
- Must: US citizen or Legal Resident. OPT students will also be considered.
